IEEE Technical Field Awards

- Awarded for contributions or leadership in specific fields of interest of the IEEE
- More closely associated with Societies and Councils than the broader IEEE
 - Narrower and more focused scope than IEEE Medals
 - But wider and less focused scope than individual Society or Council awards
- Scope aligned with the Fields of Interest of <u>multiple</u> TAB Societies and Councils
 - Otherwise would be a Society or Council award
- Sponsoring Societies/Councils
 - Provide funding
 - Provide representatives to Selection Committee



IEEE Technical Field Awards

- Award consists of plaque, certificate and honorarium
- Awarded to individual or team of individuals
 - Maximum of three (3) individuals on a team
 - Each member receives plaque and certificate but honorarium is split equally

Timeline

- Nominations due by January 31
- Committee recommends TFA recipient and alternate by March 31
- Recommendation is made to the IEEE TFA Council in April
- Recommendations endorsed by the IEEE TFA Council are forwarded to the Awards Board in April
- Recommendations endorsed by the Awards Board are forwarded to the IEEE Board of Directors in May
- IEEE Board of Directors dispositions recommendations in June



IEEE Technical Field Awards

- TFA selection committees are encouraged to review a slate of no less than four (4) candidates per award cycle
 - Two (2) of which should be new for the current award cycle
- TFA selection committee membership is a three (3) year term
 - Committee Chair is a two (2) year term



IEEE Transportation Technologies Technical Field Award

Scope

- Sustained <u>documented</u> contributions (technical or other) to transportation systems including but not limited to
 - Monitoring
 - Control
 - Power
 - Navigation
 - Communication
- Land (automotive, locomotive) air, sea

Seven sponsors

- IA-S, IE-S, ITS-S, MTT-S, PE-S, PEL-S, VT-S
- All Societies represented on committee (congratulations to you all !!)



IEEE Transportation Technologies Technical Field Award

- Every Society rep is requested to contact their Society
 - Technical Committee Chair (or equivalent) to ask for the name of a suitable candidate and nominator
 - Awards Committee Chair (or equivalent) to ask whether recent Society award recipients would qualify for this TFA
 - Conference Committee Chair (or equivalent) to request that the one-page publicity flyer be made available at any conferences held between now and the end of January 2015

- Claire Tomlin (carryover) for aircraft simulation software
- Ed Rezek has the action to contact nominators and point out weaknesses in current nomination paperwork
